With essential relevance is the presentation of the Policy Study: "Bulgaria and Romania's EU Accession: - Lessons Learned" prepared by **Dr. Dimitar Bechev**, Director of European Policy Institute, Sofia and one of the senior researchers with extensive experience on Balkans politics, history and EU relations. He received his PHD from Oxford University, while he is affiliated with University of Sofia, London School of Economics and Political Sciences (LSE) and Harvard University.

The overall goal of the project is to enhance Albanian public awareness of the EU integration as a generator of socio-economic reforms in order to promote the country's Europeanization, understanding challenges of costs-benefits, by providing specific pre and post-accession shared experiences from Greece, Bulgaria and Rumania. Under this initiative, five other activities are planned to be organized in various regions of Albania.
